The longest running program in the Council's portfolio, the ACLS Fellowship program supports outstanding scholarship in the humanities and social sciences. In the most recent competition year, ACLS awarded approximately \$3.6 million in support to 60 exceptional scholars. Supports 6-12 months of full-time research and/or writing in the humanities and interpretive social sciences. New program deadline to be announced in April.
