Fast Facts about Funding History	• Two foundations managed as one entity, with focus areas in culture, education, health and social service • Receives >1,000 grant proposals each year of which ~300 grants receive funding (~30% funding rate)
Notable Grant Opportunity	Education Program Focused on funding programs, scholarships, capital support, and (on a limited basis) general and endowment support. Give preference to college access and success programming, professional development for

educators, career pathways in STEM, and programs educating the next generation of health professionals. Minimum grant size is \$100K and applications are accepted on a rolling basis.
