<p>Notable Grant Opportunity</p>	<p>Career Development Award</p> <p>Support healthcare and academic professionals that hold an MD, PhD, DO, DVM, or DDS in their first years in basic, clinical, or population research science. Enables pilot studies that will provide preliminary data and training necessary to assure the applicant's future success as a research scientist. Must include a mentoring team and career development plan. Awardees receive \$231,000 over a three-year period for salary, fringe benefits, and project costs. <i>*Applicants must be American Heart Association Professional Members at the time of proposal submission.</i></p>
